Tips to Engage Your Learners

Make it relevant

Adults learn best when content is relevant to their jobs

Ask learners to work through clinical cases



Focus on content learners **need** to know

Keep it active



Explain why the topic is important

Include interactive activities every 10 minutes to improve knowledge retention. Try one of the following:

Think-Pair-Share

Learners consider a question, discuss with a neighbor, and report out

One Minute Paper

Learners write down a takehome point or an area of confusion

Audience Response

Low-tech (hand raising) to higher-tech (audience response system)

Have a Debate

Use a debate format or host a panel discussion to promote interaction

Engage your audience

We all learn best when interested and inspired



- ✓ Use an outline
- Move around the room
- Show enthusiasm
- ✓ Modulate tone, pitch, and pace
- ✓ Be a storyteller, pause strategically



- X Stand behind the podium
- X Avoid eye contact
- X Read off slides
- X Appear rushed or disinterested
- X Include too much content
